We take the time to listen to you, to understand your strengths and work with you to take the next step into employment.

Your individual program is developed in conjunction with your Employment Consultant, to ensure the support provided is appropriate, effective and empowering and could include:

- Career counselling
- Resume preparation
- Individual mentoring and support
- Job seeking skills
- Interviewing techniques
- Developing personal and interpersonal skills
- Ongoing support and training, including once you have a job
- Work experience placements that fit your skills and capabilities
- Support to access appropriate tertiary education
- Liaising and negotiating with employers and co-workers

Preparing for work
