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## Vacancy - Arncliffe

**Location:** Arncliffe, NSW

**Location features:** Corner block within walking distance of Arncliffe station and local cafes and shops.

**General features:** Free standing house. Site is split into two levels, a 2-bedroom unit with a shared lounge/diner, kitchen bathroom and laundry on the lower level and a 4 bedroom with shared lounge/diner, kitchen and bathroom on upper level. Both levels have their own entrances and the lower level unit has direct access to a small garden/patio area.

**Site layout:** Brick built with additional environmental modifications installed to accommodate individuals with complex behaviours of concern.

**Current staffing:** 24 x 7 with active waking night.

**Total number of residents:** 2

**Ideal candidates:** Aged 18-40 and NDIS participant who has complex behaviours of concern and is eligible for SIL funding.

**Forecast availability date:** Available now

**The people living here:**



- Current resident is 1 male living on the upper level and 1 female living on the lower level
- Age range is 21-22 years

**The support available:**



- Individuals with a psychosocial disability (intellectual disability; severe and enduring mental illness, trauma) and/or complex behaviours of concern who have mild to moderate functional support needs, display high or very high risks and may have contact with a number of service systems
- Staff are trained to support individuals with complex behaviours of concern support needs
- Psychologist located to the site to provide behaviour support and therapy (subject to the individual's NDIS funding)
- The service model has capacity to implement restricted practices where required (in line with current legislation and best practice).
