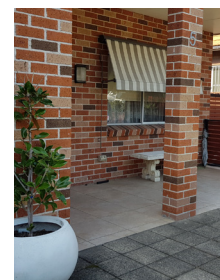
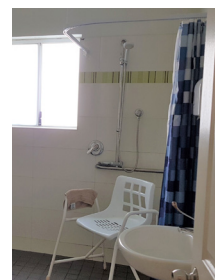
### Who we are
