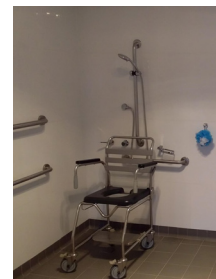
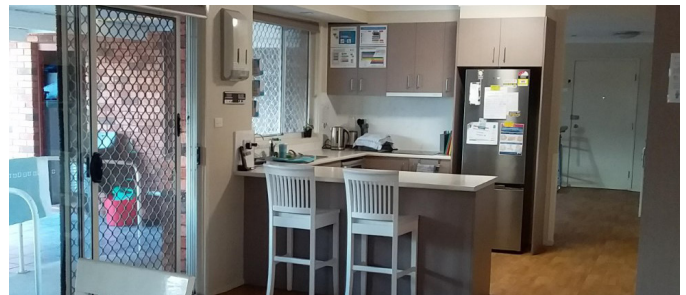
Who we are
