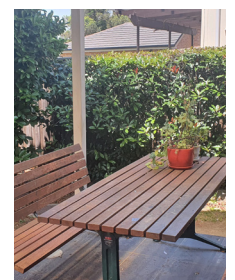
#### Who we are

## Vacancy - Holroyd Rd, Merrylands

**Location:** Merrylands in the Cumberland LGA, NSW

**Location features:** Modern duplex within walking distance to public transport and a short trip to local shops, amenities, parks, etc.

**General features:** 2 units in double storey duplex. Each unit has 3 bedrooms on the upper level, master with ensuite and balcony, shared bathroom for bedrooms 2 and 3. Downstairs has shared living areas, kitchen, laundry and access to a large backyard with covered pergola.

**Site layout:** Brick built double storey modern duplex.

**Current staffing:** 24 x 7 with an active awake shift overnight

**Total number of residents:** Currently 3 vacancies, capacity for 6

**Ideal candidates:** 25+ males and 20+ females

**Forecast availability date:** Available now

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**The people living here:**



- Current residents are 3 men and 1 woman
- Age range is 24-52

**The support available:**



- The house has support on site 24 x 7 including an active waking night
- Individuals with a psychosocial disability (intellectual disability, severe and enduring mental illness, trauma) and/or complex behaviours of concern who have mild to moderate functional support needs, display moderate to high risks and may have contact with a number of service systems
- Staff are trained to support individuals with complex behaviours of concern support needs
- Psychologist allocated to the site to provide behaviour support and therapy (subject to the individual's NDIS funding)
- The service model has capacity to implement restricted practices where required (in line with current legislation and best practice).
