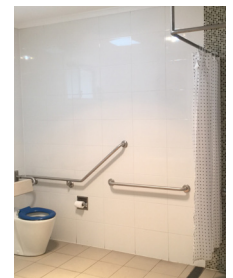
Who we are

Location: Southern Tablelands, under the Goulburn/Mulwaree Council

Location features: One free standing villa in a complex of 4 villas, a short drive to the city centre. Buses & accessible taxis available

General features: The villa has two bedrooms, a shared large bathroom, a large living and dining area, with ducted airconditioning. It has an open plan kitchen, a washing machine and a courtyard with a flower and vegetable garden. A large communal covered area with a BBQ and seating.

Site layout: Specialist Disability Accommodation (SDA) site with wheelchair access

Current staffing: 24 x 7 with sleepover shift

Total number of residents: 3, capacity for 5 people

Ideal candidates: 25-50, couples, friends or individuals who are flexible, tolerant of others, enjoy quiet time and a good mix of individual and group activities.

Forecast availability date: Available now

The people living here:



- Current residents are 2 males and 1 female with mental health diagnosis
- Age range is 27 - 50

The support available:



- The SDA has support on site 24 x 7 including a sleepover shift
- Staff supporting people in this service have specific skills, training and competencies in supporting people with mental health and intellectual disabilities
- The house has a fully maintained accessible vehicle
