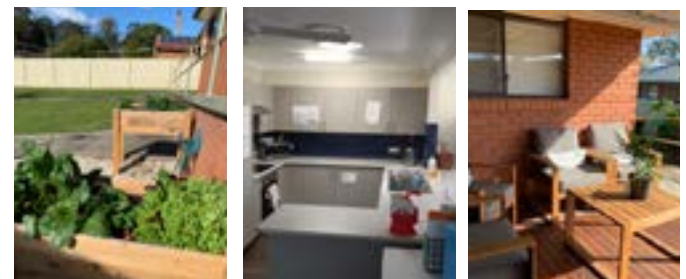


### Spacious group home in picturesque Picton.
