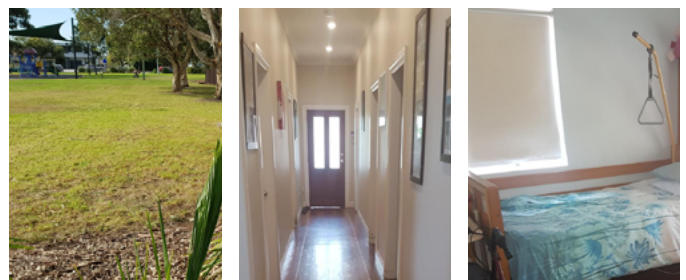


### Modern home in quiet residential street.
