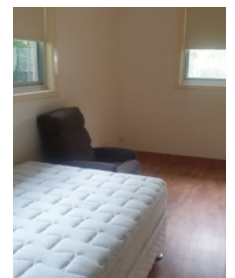


Modern villa on quiet residential street.
