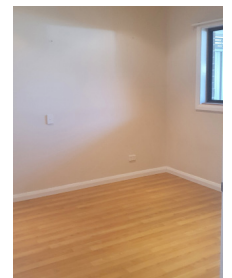


Modern self-contained villa-style units ideal for independent living.
